To learn more visit www.arts2people.org. The festival is a celebration of local art and business, with all of the performers, food vendors, and artists being from Western North Carolina. Last year we had an estimated 10,000 hungry visitors who consumed 22 kegs of beer!

As always, we are interested in certain food vendors because we want to strike a balance between food that all kinds of festival goers can enjoy, and food that is fresh, healthy, and prepared by food artisans that reflect care in their creations. We prefer booths to have an approachable, homespun aesthetic, as opposed to anything that looks really corporate. Please look over the following guidelines.

- Please include a menu, so we can work to avoid competition between booths.
- Please serve cold drinks (such as tea) and cold foods wherever possible. No corporate sodas please.
- Don't sell water. LAAFF sells water.
- All food vendors will be inspected by the Buncombe County Health department in the morning before the festival opens. Avoid hassles by contacting them NOW for guidelines.
- Booth spaces (10'x10') are \$150 or 15% of sales, whichever is greater. You may choose to do both, which we greatly appreciate!
- Booth spaces are maximum 10 x 20, flame retardant and weighted down, as per City requirement.
- Those wishing to serve meat, please advise us individually. If you have served meat at LAAFF in past years, and want to serve it exactly the same way, that's fine.
- Booths must be opened and manned for the entirety of the festival, 11am to 10 pm.
- Booth fees are non-refundable.
- A fee may be required for fried foods.
